## "Staying Resilient Series – Human Capital: Searching for Talent"

The business environment for SMEs is rather difficult at the moment. To help SMEs develop strategies in this adversity, the Support and Consultation Centre for SMEs of the Trade and Industry Department, together with the Hong Kong SME Development Federation Limited and the Innovative Entrepreneur Association, is running the "Staying Resilient Series" seminars.
