The Mainland and Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA) is a free trade agreement concluded by the Mainland of China and Hong Kong in 2003. CEPA opens up the huge Mainland market for Hong Kong goods and services. Hong Kong products that fulfil the CEPA rules of origin can enjoy zero tariff benefit upon importation into the Mainland. Hong Kong service suppliers can enjoy preferential treatments in various service sectors for access to the Mainland market. The amended CEPA Agreement on Trade in Services has been smoothly implemented since 1 June 2020, introducing new liberalisation measures in a number of important services sectors. In addition to the liberalisation measures applicable to the whole of Mainland, measures have also been introduced for pilot implementation in the Guangdong Province. These measures make it easier for Hong Kong service suppliers and professionals to set up enterprises and develop business in the Mainland, capturing the tremendous opportunities brought by the National 14th Five-Year Plan. In this seminar, a representative from the Trade and Industry Department will give you an update on the latest CEPA benefits and answer some frequently asked questions.
