Entered into force in January this year, the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) is at present the world's largest free trade agreement. Not only would the enterprises be benefited directly from RCEP on tariff reduction, but the enterprises could also accelerate the pace of globalising their businesses, capitalise on the production and sourcing advantages, and capture the business opportunities brought by RCEP. In light of this, this webinar will explore the impact of regional economic integration on supply chain, especially on rules of origin and tariff reduction. Representative from the Hong Kong Customs and Excise Department will be invited to introduce the preferential tariff treatment under the Free Trade Agreement Transshipment Facilitation Scheme with respect of the RCEP, while representative from the Hong Kong Productivity Council will introduce the “FTA and IPPA Programme” (covering ASEAN Member States) under the “Dedicated Fund on Branding, Upgrading and Domestic Sales” (BUD Fund).
