"Innovative Talent Management in the Changing Labour Market"

The population projections of the Census and Statistics Department indicate that the local labour force will enter a shrinking cycle in 2018. Labour force participation rate will drop from 58.8% in 2012 to 49.5% in 2041. Manpower shortage will become a major challenge for the operation and long term development of all industries. This seminar has invited managers from three enterprises of different businesses to share their experience in developing innovative talent management measures, with a view to facilitating participants in coping with the declining labour force. Representative from the Employees Retraining Board (ERB) will also introduce free services offered by the ERB in supporting the employment and training needs of employers.
