## "Enhancing Operation Efficiency and Customer Service of Shops"

Online shops and online shopping have become increasingly popular in recent years. They have changed the consumption habit of many people and impacted adversely on traditional physical retail shops. Traditional retail industry also faces pressure from increases in rental and operational costs. All these factors impose significant challenges for SME operators. This seminar will explore effective strategies that traditional retail industry may use to enhance operation efficiency of shops and improve service quality. The seminar will also introduce the Retail Technology Adoption Assistance Scheme for Manpower Demand Management (ReTAAS), which aims at helping the retail industry to adopt relevant information and communications technology and other technologies to help manage manpower demand and enhance productivity.
