Expand Your Operations in Vietnam

In recent years, Vietnam has developed rapidly and become the world's second largest exporters after mainland China with the surging production growth. Vietnam has attracted many foreign manufacturing industries as well as Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEM) to set up factories in the region. Under the Vietnamese government's vigorous promotion of industrial preferential policies and favorable trade agreements, Vietnam's political and social environment has been stabilized, a young and cost-effective labor market has been established while the technology and industrial chain has become more mature.
